Seminar week, 17. March 2024
until 23. March 2024



Our seminar week addresses Ukraine's housing crisis amid the ongoing war by repurposing a Lviv municipal house. We focus on redesigning internal spaces and urban integration for permanent housing. In close collaboration with Ukrainian architects, city officials as well as Swiss and international experts, students will contribute to revitalise the building for internally displaced people in Ukraine. The seminar week consists of a design and material salvaging phase, visits and a hands-on mock-up building phase. Food will be prepared collectively.
