### Exploring Urban Atmospheres

**What contribution are architecture and urban design making to the development of Zurich today?**

System design is explored in space and time looking at co-production, housing and environment, but also at the role of the arts, social-justice, migration, integration, security, and mobility. Our profession is increasingly important, as Zürich has become a world class city offering one of the best qualities of life, whilst there are areas, topics and blind spots we don't have on our radar.

How is design manifesting itself developing social and environmental responses, where can we see opportunities, challenges and possible solutions?
