

Exploring Sarajevo

How are cities, architecture, public spaces, and natural environments shaped, re-constructed, and appropriated through socio-political transitions?

Sarajevo is a spectacular archival collage of multilayered morphologies and urban responses in what is known as the Jerusalem of Europe.

As an extension to The Vienna Biennale for Change 2021, addressing Climate Care, Studio Mobil is an urban laboratory that functions as a large-scale public sculpture engaging in qualitative and quantitative research in urban environments, producing knowledge through activism, participation and exchange. The livability of future cities will ultimately depend on translating analysis to a hypothesis.

We will explore the performative potential of the city's urban commons, networks, natural resources, tangible and intangible heritage to creating new urban imaginaries. Students will visit the chairs collaborative City Action Lab, engage with the Sarajevo Urban Transformation Project with SECO, and will interact with students of the University of Sarajevo, Faculty of Architecture. During Fall Semester '21, the chair will have a permanent presence in Sarajevo, with the "Studio-Mobil" in the city.
