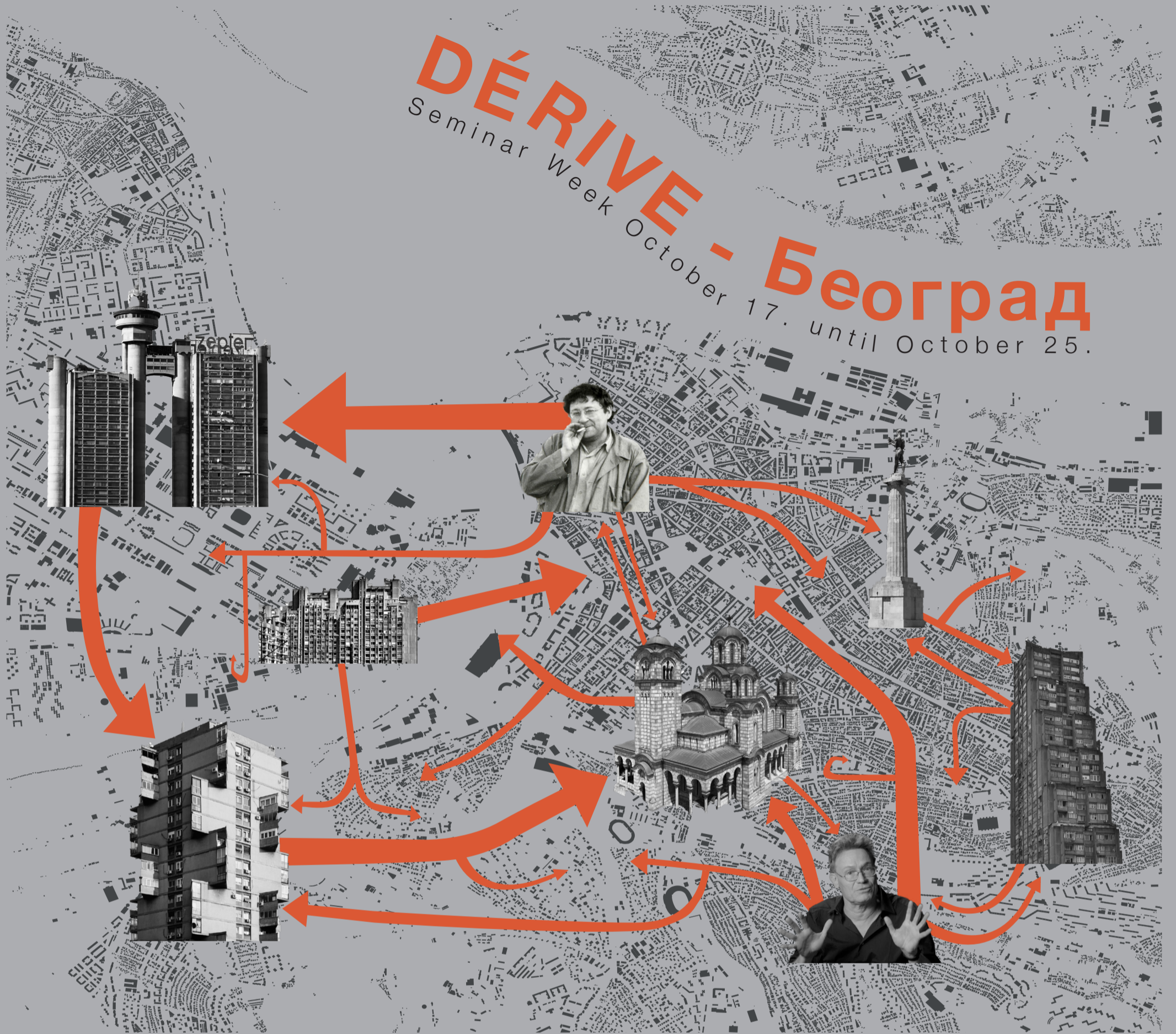


DÉRIVE - Београд

Seminar Week October 17. until October 25.



Join architektura on its first seminar week. We will explore the Serbian capital beyond the usual tourist routes and develop individual approaches to the city through the technique of dérive – aimless but conscious drifting.

Belgrade is currently undergoing radical change: large-scale projects such as Belgrade Waterfront are transforming entire neighbourhoods, while historic buildings, socialist housing complexes and appropriated open spaces coexist side by side.

By wandering aimlessly, we experience the city in an unplanned way and sharpen our awareness of atmospheres, breaks and inconspicuous transitions. In this sense, we also understand the journey as an exercise to expand our perception of urban spaces: from large scale structures to intimate moments.

We explore the traces of socialist urban planning as well as the challenges of contemporary urban development. Encounters with local students and experts will open up new perspectives. At the same time, we are creating our own map of Belgrade: using sketches, photos, sounds and texts, we are condensing individual impressions into a multifaceted representation of the city.
